The park offers interpretive programs; a visitor center with an interactive exhibit; five hiking trails, including a 1/4-mile, barrier-free historical trail and a 23.5-mile multi-use trail; an all weather public shooting range; regulated seasonal hunting; and undeveloped access to the lake. 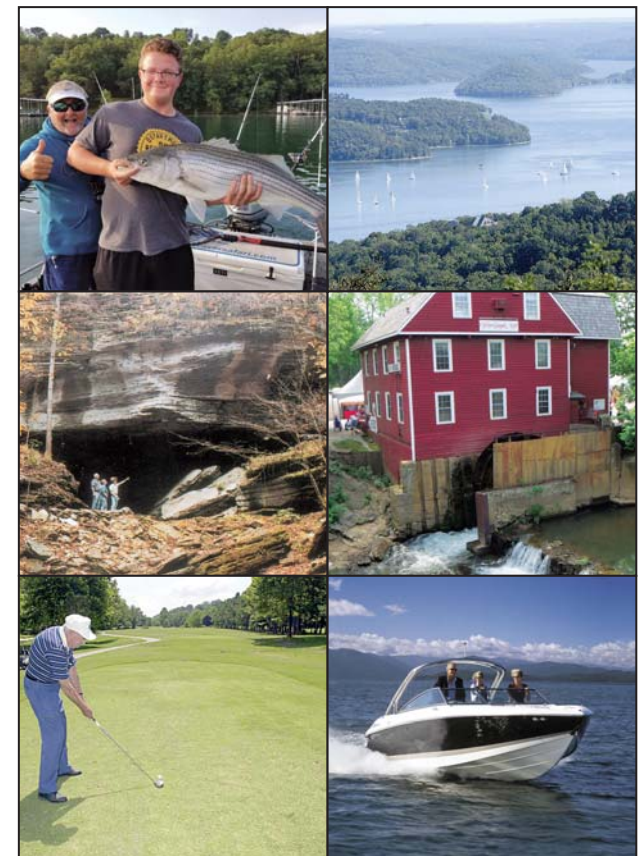
